



# PEMA Celebrates 20 Year Anniversary at its AGM 2024 in Ireland with its largest international members event



Record numbers of the port manufacturing representative association gather in Killarney, Ireland for 20th anniversary celebrations and PEMA AGM 2024.

Welcomed to Ireland for the first time to celebrate the PEMA 20th anniversary and attend the 2024 AGM, PEMA members and delegates from every corner of the world gathered at The Europe Resort & Hotel in Killarney, County Kerry, Ireland.

Held in one of the most stunning landscapes, Killarney, home of the manufacturing plant of Liebherr Container Cranes, the Annual General Meeting took place on Wednesday 10th & Thursday 11th April 2024. Members, invited guests and speakers were welcomed to Ireland to network, participate in panel discussions and technical committee meetings. The participants





were treated to an exclusive Liebherr factory tour, heard insightful speakers, and enjoyed networking events including the 20th anniversary celebration Liebherr Gala Dinner.

The afternoon was followed by Technical Committee Meetings moderated by PEMA's Head of Technology, Pat O'Leary, who was joined by the chairs and vice-chairs of PEMA's three Technical Committees. Invited speaker Pietro Foschi, former executive director of BSi gave a presentation on the criteria and process for the development of International standards.

Over the course of the afternoon, participants provided insights and had in-depth discussions on technical issues relating to the sector and on the white papers topics under development and planned.

Prior to the commencement of the AGM on Thursday morning, PEMA President Achim Dries invited Patricia Rüf and Dominique Popesco, wife of the late PEMA President Ottonel to plant a tree in celebration of the PEMA 20th year anniversary on the Avenue of Appreciation and as part of The Europe Hotel & Resort commitment to sustainability.
