People on the Move: New CEO at SC Ports, ICHCA gets a new Chair

In this edition of *People on the Move*, we highlight key industry appointments and leadership changes shaping the maritime and logistics sectors.

The International Cargo Handling Association (ICHCA) has elected **Scott McKay** as its new Chair, effective 30 September. McKay, founder and CEO of Flywheel Advisory and T Ports, brings nearly four decades of experience in global supply chain management. He replaces **John Beckett**, who steps down after 18 years on the board, including eight as Chair. McKay said ICHCA “has a fantastic opportunity to further develop and share safety data and best practice to help improve safety decisions and cultural change along and across the cargo supply chain.” McKay joined a state chapter of ICHCA Australia seven years ago. He was appointed Chair and became a member of the international board in November 2023.
